*** Relay Parking Suggestions & Relay Bus Schedule ***
(Do not park on any part of the race course at any time!)

Mile 5 Exchange: The 5 mile exchange point is at the Dallas Theater Center parking lot between Lemmon Avenue and Blackburn Street. There is no parking for relay runner vehicles in the Theater parking lot.

The 5-person relay runners will be directed to turn right (east) from Turtle Creek onto Lemmon Ave and enter the Dallas Theater Center parking lot.. The relay exchange zone is located in the parking lot. After the exchange the relay runners will be directed onto Blackburn Street and back to the marathon course.

Parking for this exchange zone is located in parking lots along Oak Lawn and Blackburn Street.

Mile 10 Exchange: The 10 mile exchange point is located two blocks north of the marathon course on Winton Street between Norris St and Alderson St. Relay runners will be directed to take a left turn off of Ellsworth Ave up Norris St., take a right onto Winton through the relay exchange zone, and down Alderson St back to Ellsworth where the relay course rejoins the marathon course.

There are parking spots at surrounding businesses. Please do not park in a business that may be open Sunday morning or in Church parking lots.

Mile 16.5 Exchange: The 16.5 mile relay exchange point is on the east side of White Rock Lake, just south of the Bath House on the right side of the course.

DO NOT PARK along West Lake Highlands Drive. The homeowners in this area have been very effective in having cars towed. Some parking is allowed along Northcliff Drive between the Bath House and W. Lake Highlands Drive. The Relay/Sag Bus will be located within the Bath House Parking Lot. **DO NOT PARK IN THE AREA DESIGNATED FOR THE RELAY/SAG BUS.**

Mile 21 Exchange: The 21 mile exchange point is located on Tokelon Drive, just west of W. Lawther Drive and past the Dolly Parton Hills. The road is narrow in this location so approach the exchange zone with caution.

Parking is very limited in this neighborhood. There is street parking available between Gaston Ave and Lakeshore, or north of Lakeshore Dr. on the surrounding streets. Parking is limited to curbside parking. The Relay/Sag Bus will be located one block west near the tennis court. **There will a designated “No Parking” zone that will be used by the Relay Bus. Please do not impede access to this spot.**

Relay Bus Schedule

There will be buses available to transport relay runners to and from the exchange zones. Please make note of the pickup times listed below. The buses must stay on schedule. *Do not leave your personal belongings on the buses, as you will return on a different bus.* To take advantage of these buses, runners must maintain a minimum pace of 14.52 minutes per mile! If you anticipate that your pace is slower than that, please arrange your own transportation.

Note: If you are not on one of the buses that leaves for your exchange (for example, the buses leave for mile 10 at 7:45 am), you will have to provide your own transportation.

Relay Timing Chip:

The relay-timing chip is on a velcro strap which is typically worn around your ankle. The chip reads better the closer it is to the mats, however you may carry the strap in your hand and wave it low over the mats as you cross them.

You must turn in the strap and chip after finishing to receive your finisher medallions.

Post Race at the Finish Line:

Relay runners running the first four legs of the relay race may enter the Automobile building through the door closest to the southeast side of the building. You must have your relay race bib on to enter the building - no exceptions. After leaving the building there is no re-entry.

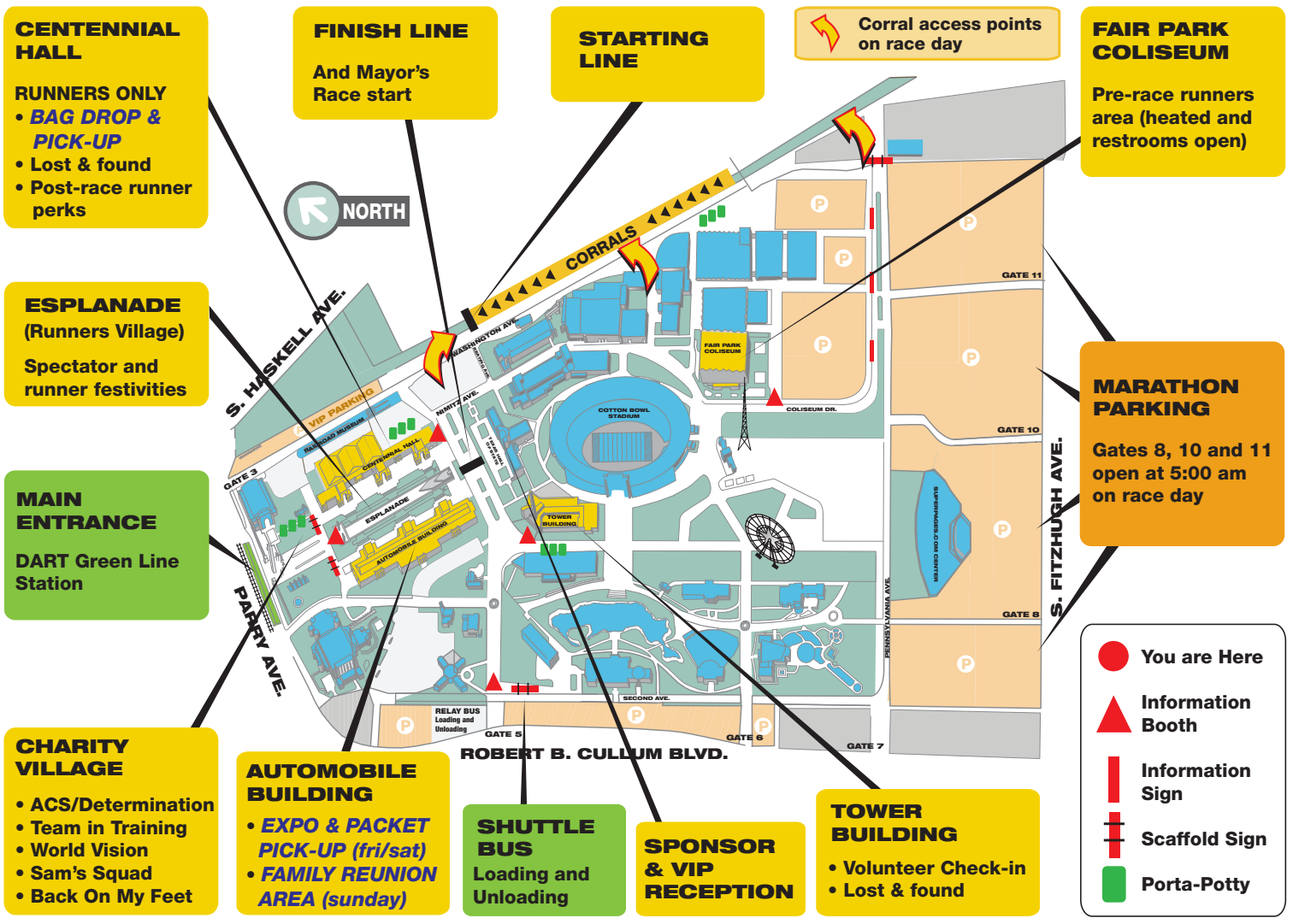
